Background Information

Thomson Pettie Rugeley Division are based in Rugeley in Staffordshire and we are looking to grow the business by investing in a new 152mm capacity all electric bending machine. The purchase of this bender forms part of a wider project for which European Regional Development Funding is sought.

Statement of Requirements

152mm Diameter All-Electric CNC Bending Machine:

Capacity – Maximum tube O/D 154mm, suitable to bend 152mm O/D x 2mm thick stainless steel tube on one x D, also suitable to bend 154mm O/D x 2mm thick tube on a 170mm C.L.R. using 904L stainless steel.

Bed Length – 4500mm - 5000mm

Facilities - To include multi bend radii

Bend-head Direction – right/right

Maximum bend angle – 180 degrees minimum

Tooling – Must be able to accommodate some or all existing bend tooling

Controls – Full CNC

H&S – Fully enclosed safety fence, c/w guardscan or photocell entrance

Lead Time

We require the bender to be delivered and installed between June & July of 2018, or earlier if possible.

After Sales Support

Please detail Methodology for After Sales support package (i.e. electrical and mechanical support provided, servicing and breakdown support). We require this to be preferably UK based.

Budget

We anticipate the estimated cost of the 152mm All-Electric bender to be circa £360,000 and expect to receive quotes above and below all of which will be considered.

Assessment of Tenders

Tenders will be assessed and scored based on a Price and Quality Mix (Most Economically Advantageous Tender). 1000 marks are available in total:

These marks will be broken down into the following criteria:

400 marks for price

500 marks for technical merit to meet the Specification Statement of Requirements, comprising 400 marks for technical merit, 50 for lead time, 50 for methodology and Installation / Commissioning

100 marks for After Sales Support for methodology of preferably UK based engineering support and servicing.

Points awarded under the qualitative criteria will be arrived at by applying the following rationale:

Score 5 marks – where the evidence demonstrates that all of the tender requirements have been met. Response provided is excellent.

Score 4 marks - where the evidence demonstrates that most of the tender requirements have been met. Response provided is good.

Score 3 marks - where the evidence demonstrates that some of the tender requirements have been met. Response provided is satisfactory

Score 2 marks – where the evidence demonstrates clear gaps in meeting the tender requirements and is not comprehensive. Response provided is below average

Score 1 mark – where the evidence demonstrates a significant flaw in meeting the tender requirements. Response provided is poor

Score 0 marks - where no information is provided for the relevant criteria.

The total MEAT Score is arrived at by adding the total price score to the total quality score
